The Western Iowa Synod has appointed Pastor Sharon Worthington to serve as the Interim Pastor of St. Paul's while we begin the process of calling a new pastor. She is a retired ELCA pastor living in Council Bluffs.

Before her retirement she served as pastor of Grand View Lutheran in Des Moines for 19 years. A graduate of Luther Northwestern Seminary in St. Paul, MN, her seminary class was the first to graduate into the new ELCA in 1988. Her first call was to serve a newly yoked two-point parish of a former ALC and former LCA congregation in Petersburg and Dunnell, MN. She also served as a team pastor at Grace Lutheran in Sisseton, SD and as an associate pastor of Immanuel Lutheran in Forest City, IA before accepting the call to Des Moines.



Pastor Sharon is a second-career pastor. She worked as a college Financial Aid Director before answering the call to ministry.

She is excited about the possibility of Interim Ministry with St. Paul's Lutheran. She looks forward to meeting and working with you all as we begin to come back from the past pandemic year.

Church Council

Council Minutes for June 17, 2021

St. Paul Lutheran Church council met at 6:30 Thursday June 17, 2021. All members were present except for Dave. There were no devotions for this month.

Corey V. called the meeting to order. The consent agenda was discussed.

Tracy moved to approve the consent agenda. Erica seconded. The motion passed.

A question was asked about when the call committee can be formed. Corey V. stated that the call committee cannot be formed until the interim Pastor is officially hired with a signed contract. Under new business was to approve the interim pastor contract for Pastor Sharon Worthington. Pastor Sharon will be three-quarters time, this includes leading both worship services on Sundays, and she will have office hours on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings. She will work Tuesdays from home while also attending text study. When confirmation starts in the fall she will also fulfill that role on Wednesday evenings. Pastor Sharon's first day will be July 1st and her first Sunday worship services will be July 4th. The council asked the congregation to provide ideas for what we would like Pastor Sharon to address while she is here. The consensus was that she should work on visiting our homebound and members in nursing homes, outreach, day to day operations of the church, and be engaged in church activities.

JJ moved to approve the contract for Pastor Sharon Worthington as interim pastor. Cory Y. seconded. The motion passed.

COVID-19 mitigations were discussed next. Erica made a motion to make masks in the church building optional, eliminate the restrictions of every other pew, go back to the use of offering plates, and to continue to use the single serve communion cups. Tracy seconded. The motion passed.

Treynor Days community worship will be held at the community center on June 27th at 10:30 AM. We are still in need of volunteers from St. Paul to help during the service and to help with set up/take down before and after worship. A clipboard will be passed around at church for people to sign up.

The membership list was the next item discussed. There are many inactive members on the list with incorrect addresses. Liz was given permission to delete the addresses of those people and move them to the inactive list.

Online worship was then discussed. If we are going to continue with online worship services we are in need of a new way to stream services without using a cell phone. Erica made a motion to keep online worship services and approve the purchase of new equipment using the memorial fund. JJ seconded. The motion passed.

Next was an update on the lift. Some recent memorials have been designated to the lift fund, bringing us closer to our goal. We are hopeful that Reid will be able to come next week to continue with next steps.

Rental of the parsonage was then discussed. Corey V. will hire someone to come and clean the parsonage before it is rented out.

Erica made a motion to rent the parsonage at \$1,200 per month including the WIFI that is already installed. The lease will start at 6 months and then go month to month after that. Tracy seconded. The motion passed.

The July council meeting was set for Wednesday July 14, 2021 at 6:30 PM.

With no other business, Katie made a motion to adjourn the meeting. JJ seconded. The motion passed.


