Council Minutes for May 13, 2021



St. Paul Lutheran Church council met at 6:30 Thursday May 13, 2021. All members were present. Pastor Chuck led us with devotions based on Isaiah 43:1-3a, followed by prayer.

Tracy called the meeting to order. The consent agenda was discussed. Dave is continuing to work with Collins Consulting, examining active and inactive accounts and knowing the contact person for each account. The other consent agenda items were considered. Erica moved to approve the consent agenda. Cory Y. seconded. Motion passed.

Under new business, was to make a decision regarding single serve communion cups. It was discussed and decided that we would continue to use the single serve cups and to reevaluate at the June meeting. The next item of business was whether to continue mitigation efforts for COVID-19. Discussion continued. JJ moved to discontinue sanitizing of the pews, put cushions back on the pews, keep masks, but to leave every other pew blocked off. We will continue to work on these mitigation measures on a month to month basis. Tracy seconded. Motion passed.

Another item of business was the phone system. The old phone system is no longer able to be repaired. Denise was able to get a few cordless phones to use in the office. The concern is that when we have a new Pastor we would need access to a second line. Dave is currently working with Western Iowa Wireless on this issue and is hopeful to have guidance for the June meeting.

Usage of the parsonage was discussed and it was decided that Denise would be able to use the parsonage for bible story the week of Vacation Bible School. It was also discussed that after VBS we would rent out the parsonage on a month by month basis if no interim needed the housing. Tracy moved and Erica seconded. The motion passed. Denise will reach out to Tammy in regards to cleaning the parsonage between June 6th-12th.

The transition and call process was then presented. The Western Iowa Synod has shared a packet with us that we will begin working through. Pastor shared some obligations that he wanted the council to be aware of before departing. Pastors last day will be May 31, and he will be taking vacation time the rest of that week.

Pastor Chuck's Service of Thanksgiving will be held on May 30th, at both the 8:00 and 10:30 services. This will also include a farewell fellowship time for Pastor Chuck from 8:45-10:15 in the fellowship hall. All are invited to attend for this send off for Pastor. We want to take time to thank Pastor Chuck for his years of service here at St. Paul Lutheran. We are sad to see Pastor leave but are excited for you in your new call.

The next council meeting will be held on Thursday June 17, 2021 at 6:30 PM.

The last item on the agenda was an update on the lift. Supports are currently being worked on. When that is done someone will be hired to come in and tear out the remaining walls.

With no other business the meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
